

Annual Parochial Church Meeting

Each parish normally has to hold their APCM by the end of May. Because of the situation with Covid-19 and the lockdown earlier in the year, the date for holding APCM's has been extended to the end of October 2020. As we were not able to hold our APCM at St Margaret's earlier in the year, we will hold it on **Sunday 27 September.** Unless guidance about social distancing etc. changes, this year we will hold the meeting in the church, straight after the Parish Eucharist. The purpose of the APCM is to elect two Churchwardens; nine members of the Parochial Church Council; and also this year two members to represent the parish on Redbridge Deanery Synod. The period of office for officials will be truncated as they will only be in office until the next APCM, which has to be before 31 May 2021. The APCM also has to receive a reports on the proceedings of the PCC; the financial statement of the PCC for the year ending 31 December 2019; a report on changes to the Electoral Roll; a report on the proceedings of the deanery synod; a report on the fabric, ornaments and goods of the church. These will all be produced as a booklet which will be available in paper form in church, and also on our web site.

Our income for the month was £7,259 and expenditure was £10,401. Income included: £950 FWO and collections; £300 donation; £2,486 rent from Ingleby Road flats; £1,319 interest from investments with M&G Charities. Expenditure included: £4,697 monthly parish share payment to the diocese; £1,475 hall decoration; £2,394 to buy a replacement photocopier.
