
- If you have a pc or laptop these are the details you need to join: Meeting ID: 296 467 9306; Password 176040.

Transition Town Ilford

Ruth Musgrave writes: TTI isn't a campaigning organisation, but we are committed to a flourishing community and a greener Ilford. This includes cleaner air and healthier residents. Many parts of London (including parts of Redbridge) way exceed the official pollution limit levels at some times of day. You may be aware of the recent successful landmark court case of a south London mother to prove that air pollution played a large contribution to her child's death from Asthma.
