

Easter Day Worship at 10.30am

Easter Day is the most important day of the year for Christians, the day we celebrate the Resurrection of our Lord.

Our Easter Day worship begins in church at 10.30am with the Easter Ceremonies, starting with the marking of the new Easter (Paschal) Candle. This is then lit, and carried through the church to represent the light of Christ banishing death and darkness. From it, we each light a small candle, to show we carry in us the light of Christ. Later, we renew our Baptismal Vows, reminding ourselves that through Baptism, we have risen to the new life of Christ. After which, we celebrate the Easter Eucharist.
