Wearing face coverings in church

In England, face coverings are required by law to be worn in shops, supermarkets, indoor transport hubs, indoor shopping centres, banks, building societies, post offices and on public transport. From 8 August, face coverings are also required by law to be worn in a greater number of public indoor settings including places of worship, museums, galleries, cinemas and public libraries.

There are valid exemptions for some individuals and groups not to wear a face covering in these settings. In particular, those who are leading services or events in a place of worship, and those who assist them (for instance by reading, preaching, or leading prayer) do not always need to wear a face covering. These exemptions are made to enable communication, particularly with those who rely on lip-reading, facial expressions or clear sound; they do not exempt clergy and other leaders from wearing face coverings in other situations or during other activities. This exemption does not apply to worshippers, who should wear face coverings consistent with the requirements for any other public space.

Face coverings should be worn by the president and anyone assisting at the time of distribution of the consecrated host. Face coverings need not be worn by worshippers when they consume the consecrated host.

July Parish Finance

Our income for the month was £6,033 and expenditure was £6,709. Income was £1,294 from voluntary donations (collections); £1,903 hall rent; £2,486 rent from Ingleby Road flats; £350 sale of Fairtrade goods. The main item of expenditure as always is the monthly £4,697 payment to the Diocese. We also had to pay £1,044 to LB Redbridge, the annual fee for emptying the green commercial waste bin outside the church hall, plus some other smaller payments such as the monthly insurance premium of £230, and gas and electricity payment of £160
